

CITY OF SWISHER RULES FOR USE OF CASTEK PARK BALL
DIAMOND, SWISHER, IOWA and HOLD HARMLESS

1. Ball Diamond is available to residents of the City of Swisher and those residents will be given first priority.
2. Reservations must be made by **residents** of the City of Swisher, Iowa and must sign agreement with City Clerk 857-4539, or at the coaches meeting, make deposit (if required), and pick up key during business hours Monday from 9-6, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday from 8-4. Return the key the same day as reservation date to the City Hall – drop key in the City Hall door slot.
3. Reservations will be made at a special meeting in March for the upcoming ball season and can only be made one season at a time.
4. Reservations are limited to one, two-hour slot per week. Other time slots may be reserved if still available after meeting is held. City Clerk must be made aware of whether the time slots will be used for practice or a game and a game schedule must be provided. The ball diamond will not be available on Saturday and Sundays so that Swisher residents can have undisturbed access to the pavilion for family picnics and other events.
5. City Maintenance Staff will mow the diamond once weekly. Coaches will be responsible for preparation of the field.
6. Coaches will be responsible for keeping the restrooms in a clean manner, leaving the park in an orderly fashion, picking up litter, etc. after each use.
7. Coaches will be responsible for any park-owned equipment used by you and your group, and to return equipment to appropriate place and to lock concessions stand area and turn off lights when leaving the park.
8. Park closes at 10:30 p.m. and lights must be turned off by that time. The City of Swisher reserves the right to charge for light usage in the future if there is a significant rise in the cost.
9. **HOLD HARMLESS:** I have read and understand Swisher’s rules, regulations and policies for usage of Castek Park ball diamond. I agree to abide by all city rules, regulations and policies; local, state and federal laws, and understand that if I do not, any park visitor is subject to removal from Swisher property and/or prosecution. To the fullest extent of the law, I agree to defend, pay on behalf of, indemnify, and hold harmless the City of Swisher, its elected and appointed officials, employees and volunteers, and others working on behalf of the City of Swisher against any and all claims, demands, suits, or loss, including all costs connected therewith, and for any damages which may be asserted, claimed, or recovered against or from the City of Swisher by reason of personal injury or death and/or property damage, including loss of use thereof, which arises out of, or is in any way connected or associated with the ball park diamond.

I agree to abide by the rules and hold harmless listed above.
