

CITY OF SWISHER, IOWA
CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
JUNE 23, 2025

Mayor Wernimont called the Swisher City Council meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Council members Curt Cline, Daryl Hynek, Kody Pudil, and Michael Stagg were present; Adam Roeder was absent. Also present was City Clerk Shelley Annis.

Motion Pudil, 2nd Cline to approve the agenda – all aye.

Motion Cline, 2nd Stagg to approve the consent agenda items – all aye.

Motion Pudil, 2nd Hynek to approve an Event Permit for the Swisher Men’s Club Car Show on September 13, 2025 and close streets as requested from 6:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. with the city providing road closure barriers – all aye.

Motion Stagg, 2nd Pudil to approve payment of \$3,500 to the Swisher Economic Alliance group for the match of the Community Branding Grant for new signs – all aye

Kent Kraus with Eagle Point Solar presented reports of how a Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) could benefit the city by installing solar arrays at a few city properties. Kraus will revise to reflect city hall, the public works shop and sewer plant when ready.

Council discussed receipt of a second complaint of noise and home occupation at 131 Orchard St SW. Motion Pudil, 2nd Cline to discuss with the City Attorney and submit a second letter to the owner – all aye.

Motion Stagg, 2nd Cline to approve Resolution 27-2025 adopting the 2025 Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, Johnson County, Iowa. Cline, Hynek, Pudil, Stagg – aye.

Motion Pudil, 2nd Hynek to approve Resolution 28-2025 approving employee wages for FY2026 beginning July 1, 2025 and ending June 30, 2026. Hynek, Pudil, Stagg, Cline – aye.

Motion Pudil, 2nd Stagg to approve the 2nd Reading of Ordinance 19-2025 amending City Code Chapter 106.08-Collection Fee, increasing monthly solid waste collection fees. Pudil, Stagg, Cline, Hynek – aye.

Council member Stagg requested to discuss the safety concerns of golf carts traveling on Division Street regardless of the ban of golf carts on Division Street per City Code. Council directed the Mayor to communicate with the Public Works Department to add slow-moving golf cart signs between Rose Ave and Summit Streets on Division Street.

Council member Stagg requested to discuss the dead trees on Division Street and determine if new trees should be planted to replace. Council directed the Mayor to communicate with the Public Works Department to remove any dead trees and not plant new trees.

Council directed the Mayor to communicate with the Public Works Department to review the Ash Tree list and update as requested to show location of ash trees currently standing and condition.
