

ORDINANCE NO. 01-2026

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 124 (DANCE HALLS) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SWISHER, IOWA

SECTION I. PURPOSE. The purpose of this ordinance is to repeal Chapter 124 (Dance Halls) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Swisher, Iowa, which is outdated and no longer necessary for the protection of the public health, safety, and welfare. The City Council finds that the regulations contained in Chapter 124 are duplicative of, or adequately addressed by, other provisions of state law and local ordinances, and that repeal will promote clarity, efficiency, and consistency within the City's Code of Ordinances.

SECTION II. CHAPTER REPEALED. Chapter 124 of the Swisher, Iowa Code of Ordinances is hereby repealed within its entirety.

SECTION III. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION IV. SEVERABILITY. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION V. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be effective after its passage and publication as required by law.
