SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
OCTOBER 25, 2022

Call to Order: Mayor Pro-Tem Michael Stagg called Special Council Meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. on October 25, 2022, at Swisher Library, Swisher IA.

Also present: City Clerk/Finance Officer Tawnia Kakacek and applicants for public works position. Public Works Superintendent Justin Fields joined by via Zoom at 7:13 p.m.

Agenda: Motion by Heims, seconded by Neuendorf to approve the agenda. Call for vote. All ayes. Motion carried.

Mayor Taylor arrived at 6:34 p.m.

Interview Applicants for Public Works Position: Council and Mayor interviewed 3 applicants for the new full-time public works position. Fields interviewed the last 2 applicants. All applicants were asked if they wanted to go in closed session and they all declined to go into closed session.

Resolution No. 2022-56-Hire Public Works Staff: After discussion, Neuendorf moved, seconded by Stagg to approve Resolution No. 2022-56 entitled "A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE HIRING OF PUBLIC WORKS STAFF FOR CITY OF SWISHER, IOWA" to Dylan Osborn at \$17.00 per hour at 40 hours a week, \$900 monthly stipend for health insurance, short-term disability insurance effective October 26, 2022.
