

**CITY OF SWISHER, IOWA**  
**CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES**  
**June 10, 2024**

Mayor Julie Persons called the Swisher City Council meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Council members Curt Cline, Daryl Hynek, and Adam Roeder answered roll call. Council members Kody Pudil and Michael Stagg were absent. Also present was City Clerk Shelley Annis.

Motion Stagg, 2<sup>nd</sup> Pudil to approve the agenda – all aye.

Council member Kody Pudil joined the meeting at 6:31 p.m.

Motion Hynek, 2<sup>nd</sup> Roeder to approve the consent agenda – all aye.

Written reports were received by the Johnson County Sheriff's Office and Ion Environmental Solutions. The City Engineer, and Mayor gave verbal reports.

Motion Pudil, 2<sup>nd</sup> Cline to approve Resolution 28-2024 approving the Final Reimbursement of \$150.00 to the Johnson County Secondary Road Department for Phase I of the Division Street Improvement Project, accept the Project as completed and recommend that Retainage be paid to LL Pelling. Roeder, Pudil, Cline, Hynek – aye.

Motion Pudil, 2<sup>nd</sup> Roeder to approve Resolution 39-2024 awarding a contract for the Swisher 2024 Street Maintenance Project to Kluesner Construction, Farley, IA for \$44,438.90. Cline, Hynek, Pudil, Roeder – aye.

Motion Roeder, 2<sup>nd</sup> Hynek to approve Resolution 40-2024 approving Pay App No. 2 from Dave Schmitt Construction Co., Inc., Cedar Rapids, IA for \$271,023.17 for work through May 31, 2024 on the Sanitary Sewer Project. Hynek, Pudil, Roeder, Cline – aye.

Motion Roeder, 2<sup>nd</sup> Cline to approve Resolution 41-2024 approving Change Order No. 1 for \$21,990.00 increasing the Sanitary Sewer Project contract with Dave Schmitt Construction to \$3,559,649.30. Pudil, Roeder, Cline, Hynek – aye.

Motion Pudil, 2<sup>nd</sup> Roeder to approve Resolution 42-2024 approving employee wages for FY2025 beginning July 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2025. Roeder, Cline, Hynek, Pudil – aye.

Motion Pudil, 2<sup>nd</sup> Roeder to approve Resolution 43-2024 appointing Amanda Stallman, 314 1<sup>st</sup> Street SW, Swisher, IA to the Swisher Park and Recreation Board with her term expiring on December 31, 2027. Cline, Hynek, Pudil, Roeder – aye.

Motion Pudil, 2<sup>nd</sup> Cline to approve Resolution 44-2024 transferring \$290,822.50 from the LOST Fund, \$68,626.25 from the TIF Fund, and \$164.36 from the Sewer Fund to Debt Service Funds to make the June 1, 2024 Bond and Loan Principal & Interest payments for the City. Cline, Hynek, Pudil, Roeder – aye.

City Engineer Cutsforth reported on the ash trees identified on Swisher View Drive. Since no ash trees can be removed until after September 30<sup>th</sup>, Council will determine which trees to remove this fall and if they will go over the \$5,000 budgeted in FY2025.

Council member Pudil requested a discussion of the process by which a nuisance is reported to the City. Pudil understood that a person reporting a nuisance was required to give their name. City Clerk Annis

consulted the City Attorney on this and corrected this information in that a name is not required. Clerk Annis will receive nuisance information, direct the Public Works Superintendent to get photos of the nuisance and if warranted, issue a nuisance letter. Council will receive copies of the letters and photos in their next packet.

Motion Roeder, 2<sup>nd</sup> Pudil to adjourn the meeting at 7:07 p.m. – all aye.
