

**CITY OF SWISHER, IOWA  
CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
JANUARY 13, 2025**

Mayor Brian Wernimont called the Swisher City Council meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Council members Curt Cline, Daryl Hynek, Adam Roeder, and Michael Stagg were present. Council member Kody Pudil was absent. Also present was City Clerk Shelley Annis.

Motion Stagg, 2<sup>nd</sup> Roeder to approve the agenda – all aye.

Motion Cline, 2<sup>nd</sup> Roeder to approve the consent agenda – all aye.

Council member Pudil joined the meeting at 6:33 p.m.

Motion Pudil, 2<sup>nd</sup> Cline to approve an Event Permit for the Swisher Youth Sports “Touch A Truck” event on Thursday, May 22, 2025 from 5:30 – 7:00 p.m. and close Rose Ave, 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave, Central Ave and the alley north of the Legion for the event – all aye.

Mayor Wernimont opened a public hearing at 6:42 p.m. on proposed plans, specifications, form of contract and estimate of cost for the proposed 2025 Sanitary Sewer Lining Project. With no comment having been received prior to the hearing, and no one in attendance or participating electronically commenting, Mayor Wernimont closed the public hearing at 6:43 p.m.

Motion Pudil, 2<sup>nd</sup> Stagg to approve Resolution 01-2025 finally approving and confirming Plans, Specifications, Form of Contract and Estimate of Cost for the 2025 Sanitary Sewer Lining Project. Hynek, Pudil, Roeder, Stagg, Cline – aye.

Motion Pudil, 2<sup>nd</sup> Stagg to approve Resolution 02-2025 to Provide for Notice of Taking of Bids for the 2025 Sanitary Sewer Lining Project. Pudil, Roeder, Stagg, Cline, Hynek – aye.

HR Green Engineer Melissa Clow reported that the City held a bid opening at 1:00 p.m. on Monday, January 13, 2025 for the 2025 Sanitary Sewer Lining Project. Four bids were received. HR Green reviewed the bids and recommends award to Municipal Pipe Tool, Hudson, IA.

Motion Pudil, 2<sup>nd</sup> Roeder to approve Resolution 03-2025 awarding a contract for the 2025 Sanitary Sewer Lining Project to Municipal Pipe Tool Company LLC, Hudson, IA for \$159,122.74. Roeder, Stagg, Cline Hynek, Pudil – aye.

Mayor Wernimont opened a public hearing at 6:49 p.m. on the City of Swisher FY2025 Budget Amendment #1. With no comment having been received prior to the hearing, and no one in attendance or participating electronically commenting, Mayor Wernimont closed the public hearing at 6:50 p.m.

Motion Stagg, 2<sup>nd</sup> Pudil to approve Resolution 04-2025 approving the City of Swisher FY2025 Budget Amendment #1. Stagg, Cline, Hynek, Pudil, Roeder – aye.

City Clerk Annis reported that the City will have the vote for Local Option Sales Tax (LOST) on the March 4, 2025 ballot and asked Council ways they would want to get the word out to the public. Council discussed the importance of LOST Revenues to the City and wants the public to know the Council supports LOST for Swisher. Information will be provided on utility bills, newsletters, via facebook and the City website.

Motion Stagg, 2<sup>nd</sup> Hynek to approve the list of utility bill messages to be placed onto the 2025 utility bills – all aye.

Council discussed the dangerous building ordered on 78 Rose Ave. Motion Roeder, 2<sup>nd</sup> Pudil to fine the property owner \$500.00 for the next thirty (30) days and Council member Hynek will reach out to the owner about getting this cleaned up. Mayor Wernimont called for a vote of the Council members with Stagg, Hynek, Roeder, Cline and Pudil voting aye.

Motion Pudil, 2<sup>nd</sup> Roeder to adjourn the meeting at 7:17 p.m. – all aye.
