**REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING**

**Call to Order:** Mayor Daryl Brown called the city council meeting to order at 6:30PM.

**Consent Agenda:** Hynek motioned, seconded by Stagg to approve the consent agenda. Roll Call Vote: Ayes – Pudil, Wernimont, Hynek, Stagg, Cline. Nays – None. Motion carried.

**Public Comment:** Greg Erceg introduced himself as running for District 1 Board of Supervisors.

**Motion to Approve Mallorie Krob as officer of TCM Bank credit cards and to close Justin Fields credit card** – Cline motioned, seconded by Wernimont to approve Mallorie Krob as officer of TCM Bank Credit Cards and to close Justin Fields credit card. Roll Call Vote: Ayes – Wernimont, Pudil, Stagg, Cline, Hynek. Nays – None. Motion carried.

**Dancemor Dance Hall Permit** – DanceMor Dance Hall permit expired in September 2025 and has not been renewed. This information was provided to the owner’s of DanceMor, Nick and Rebekah Neuendorf. Nick and Rebekah Neuendorf were present at meeting and provided a written statement to be added to the council packet in support of changing the dance hall ordinance. Pudil motioned to table item until the next meeting on April 13<sup>th</sup>, 2026 where the Dance Hall Ordinance, permit and sheriff coverage will be reviewed and after Neuendorf’s, Mayor Brown and Sheriff Kunkle meet on April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026. Council agreed to table until next meeting.

**Authorize Date of Amnesty Day with N&N Sanitation** – Stagg motioned, seconded by Wernimont to authorize May 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2026 as amnesty day with N&N Sanitation. Roll Call Vote: Ayes – Wernimont, Pudil, Stagg, Hynek, Cline. Nays – None. Motion carried.

**Review Lawn Mowing Bids and Award Bid** – Pudil motioned, seconded by Cline to award bid to SK Mowing for lawn mowing for 2026. Roll Call Vote: Ayes – Hynek, Cline, Pudil, Stagg, Wernimont Nays- None. Motion carried.

**Review Lawn Chemical Application Bids and Award Bid** – Pudil motioned, seconded by Cline to award bid to TruGreen for Lawn Chemical Application for 2026. Roll Call Vote: Ayes – Hynek, Stagg, Cline, Wernimont, Pudil. Nays – None. Motion carried.

**Review Code on Charging Vacant Units for Utilities** – Council discussed not having shut-offs to track usage for vacant units and the lack of ability to determine whether a unit is actually vacant. Council chose to take no action on this item.
