SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
JUNE 21, 2021

In order to help stop the spread of the COVID-19 virus, this meeting was also held electronically. Chapter 21.8 of the Iowa Code permits electronic meetings where members participate remotely when in-person meeting is impossible or impractical. Anyone could attend in person, dial in or connect electronically to hear the actual meeting.

Call to Order: Mayor Christopher Taylor called Special Council Meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. on June 21, 2021 at Swisher Library, Swisher IA.

Council Present: Rebekah Neuendorf, James Rowe and Michael Stagg. Via conference call was Mary Gudenkauf. She arrived in person at 8:50 p.m. Absent: Kody Pudil.

Also present: City Clerk Tawnia Kakacek and applicants for Public Works position.

Agenda: Motion by Stagg, seconded by Gudenkauf to approve the agenda. Call for vote. All yes. Absent: Pudil. Motion carried.

Interview Applicants: Mayor and Council interviewed 3 applicants for position of Public Works Superintendent. Gudenkauf signed off at 8:33 p.m. and rejoined by zoom at 8:40 p.m., then arrived in person at 8:50 p.m.

Resolution No. 2021-27-Hire Superintendent of Public Works: After lengthy discussion, Rowe moved, seconded by Neuendorf to approve Resolution No. 2021-27 entitled "A RESOLUTION APPROVING HIRING THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR CITY OF SWISHER, IOWA" to Clayton Cross. Council noted if Cross doesn't accept position, this position would be readvertised.
