Call to Order: Mayor Christopher Taylor called Special Council Meeting to order at 5:30 p.m. at Swisher City Hall, Swisher, Iowa on June 26, 2019.

Council Present: Mary Gudenkauf, Rebekah Neuendorf, James Rowe, Michael Stagg. Absent: Jerry Hightshoe.

Also present: City Clerk Tawnia Kakacek, Librarian Laura Hoover.

Agenda: Motion by Neuendorf, seconded by Stagg to approve the agenda. Call for vote. All ayes. Absent: Hightshoe. Motion carried.

Resolution No. 2019-32-Approve Grant Application and Official State for Castek Park: Librarian Hoover stated Parks & Recreation Commission wanted to submit this grant to concrete the trail at Castek Park and she has been working the P & R Member Ed Kringle to submit this by July 1,2019. Kakacek noted the city budgeted \$10,000 next year for this project and the grant application would be asking for additional \$30,000. Gudenkauf recommended to add “Walk the Signs” on the trail as she has seen in other communities. Hoover will incorporate this and working with the library on those signs into the application as library has donated funds for this. After review and discussion, Gudenkauf moved, seconded by Stagg, to approve Resolution No. 2019-32 entitled “RESOLUTION TO APPROVE SUBMITTING IOWA STATE RECREATIONAL TRAILS GRANT APPLICATION AND OFFICIAL ENDORSEMENT”. Roll call vote. Ayes: Gudenkauf, Neundorf, Rowe, Stagg. Nays: None. Absent: Hightshoe. Resolution No. 2019-32 passed. Council thanked Hoover and Park & Recreation for their initiative on this.
