

**CITY OF SWISHER
ORDINANCE NO. 296**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF SWISHER, IOWA, SECTION 99.01 SEWER SERVICE CHARGES REQUIRED AND REMOVING BILLING RATE FOR 2016 TO 2017 AND THEREAFTER

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SWISHER, IOWA:

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend Section 99.01 of the Municipal Code of Swisher, Iowa, by modifying the sewer service charges required and removing billing rate for 2016 to current rate.

Section 2. Amendment. Section 99.01 of the Municipal Code of Swisher, Iowa is hereby repealed and the following is adopted:

99.01 SEWER SERVICE CHARGES REQUIRED. Each customer shall pay sewer service charges, for the use of and for the service supplied by the municipal sanitary sewer system in accordance with the following:

September 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024 Rate:

1. Residential – Each customer **per connection** shall pay a charge of \$61.75 per month.
2. Commercial – Each customer **per connection** shall pay a charge of \$101.75 per month.

July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2025

1. Residential – Each customer **per connection** shall pay a charge of \$73.00 per month.
2. Commercial – Each customer **per connection** shall pay a charge of \$120.50 per month.

July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2026

1. Residential – Each customer **per connection** shall pay a charge of \$84.25 per month.
2. Commercial – Each customer **per connection** shall pay a charge of \$139.25 per month.

July 1, 2026 and thereafter

1. Residential – Each customer **per connection** shall pay a charge of \$95.50 per month.
Commercial – Each customer **per connection** shall pay a charge of \$158.00 per month

Section 3. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Severability. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole, or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in effect after its final passage, approval, and posting as provided by law.
